Children arriving after this time will be recorded as late on the school register. **Persistent lateness will be reported to the Education Welfare Service**. Article 45 Schedule 1 of the Children NI Order states that the Education Welfare Service can fine families up to £1000.00 for failing to ensure that their children attend school. The Education Welfare Officer visits school regularly to monitor attendance.

Parents of P2-P7 children are reminded that they should not enter the school playground but leave their child/children at the school gates.

P1 – P3 children MUST be collected each day from school by a responsible adult. They **should not** walk home alone.
